

# **Transcripts**



#### Do I need to send transcripts?

Each individual program decides the types of transcripts you must submit. This information is displayed at the bottom of the <u>Colleges Attended</u> page once you add your institution(s).

- If your program requires official transcripts, you can request these
  electronically from National Student Clearinghouse and Parchment, or
  by mail. See the <u>Sending Official Transcripts to NursingCAS</u> page for
  more information.
- If your program requires unofficial transcripts, click Upload and attach any associated transcripts.

#### Where do I find the Transcript ID Form?

The Transcript ID Form is found in the <u>Colleges Attended</u> section after you submit a college or university entry.



## What should I do if I have transcripts from schools outside of the United States?

If you attended a foreign school or earned your degree outside of the United States, most NursingCAS programs require you to submit your foreign coursework to a US-based evaluation service for a course-by-course US equivalency report. This report should then be sent directly to NursingCAS from the evaluation service.

Contact the foreign transcript evaluation service as early as possible as services can take several weeks to process your transcript(s) once received.

### Should I send my high school transcripts?

Some programs may require high school transcripts. If a program indicates they require a high school transcript, please contact them directly for more information.



### My transfer credits are listed on my primary transcript. Do I still need to send all transcripts?

You must report all colleges and universities attended, even if your transfer credits are listed on your primary transcript.



#### How do I know what my primary institution is?

Your primary institution is the college or university where you earned or will earn your first bachelor's degree.
